Work Health and Safety

- * Should any injury occur to you while you are acting as a volunteer of the Archdiocese you must notify your Parish Priest / Parish Administrator immediately, or as soon as practicable.
- * Any incident which occurs in which injury or property damage to other parties may arise must be reported immediately or as soon as practicable to your Parish Priest / Parish Administrator.
- * Under the terms of the NSW *Work Health and Safety Act 2011* you must follow established practices, procedures and instructions of the Parish which apply to the task you have volunteered to perform.

Child Protection

- * If your Parish Priest / Parish Administrator requires you to obtain and/or maintain a current Working with Child Check under the *Child Protection (Working with Children) Act 2012* (NSW), you will provide him with the information he requires to verify that you are cleared to work with children. Your engagement in this position is subject to that clearance.
- * If you are volunteering in a role in which you will have, or are expected to have contact with children, you must comply with the Archdiocese’s child protection policies and procedures.
- * If a National Criminal History Record Check is required, the relevant form will be provided to you. Your engagement in this position is subject to the results of that check (if required).
