MINISTRY TRAINING AND RE-TRAINING

After the last couple of years our parish rosters are a bit "out of date". Therefore over the next few months I would like to renew these ministries with re-training and new training for people who wish to minister in the parish.

None of these roles is about "helping father"! They are about ministering/serving to your brothers and sisters. Remember this is **your** parish, **your** community. My role as priest is to serve and lead you in faith — not to control you.



Another point to note is that everyone who celebrates Mass as part of our community is worthy to take on any of these roles of ministry. So often people say to me they don't feel worthy! If that was the case, then I wouldn't be a priest. It's not about worthiness — it's about living out our baptismal sacrament of service.

Proclaimers of the Word

Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion

All current Extraordinary ministers, and new people need to attend one of the following dates, please contact Fr Bernie if you cannot attend either of the two options.

Option 1: Saturday 20th August 11.15am | Option 2: Friday 26th August 7pm

Altar Serving and Acolyte Training

Option 1: Sunday 21st of August 3.30pm – following the training you are expected to remain for Mass to watch the role in action, by one of our acolytes.

Option 2: Saturday 3rd of September 3.30pm – following the training you are expected to remain for Mass to watch the role in action, by one of our acolytes.

An Acolyte is a formally instituted ministry within the Church structure and thereby requires certain training and protocols. To be instituted as an Acolyte you must be over 18 years old. Until recently this was only a role for men, but Pope Francis recently opened this role to women, so I am hoping we can have both male and female Acolytes. The role of Acolyte doubles as a sacristan – so once you have been instituted as an Acolyte you are expected to arrive in time (at least 30 minutes before Mass starts) to prepare the sanctuary for Mass.

An Altar Server is the same as the above, but without the formal title. The only difference being that you need to be 18 years old to formally hold the title of Acolyte.

ENTRANCE ANTIPHON:

Look to your covenant, O Lord, and forget not the life of your poor ones for ever. Arise, O God, and defend your cause, and forget not the cries of those who seek you.

FIRST READING: WISDOM 18:6-9

The night of the deliverance from Egypt was made known beforehand to our ancestors, so that they might rejoice in sure knowledge of the oaths in which they trusted.

The deliverance of the righteous and the destruction of their enemies were expected by your people. For by the same means by which you punished our enemies you called us to yourself and glorified us.

For in secret the holy children of good people offered sacrifices, and with one accord agreed to the divine law, so that the saints would share alike the same things, both blessings and dangers; and already they were singing the praises of the ancestors. This also is vanity.

SECOND READING: HEBREWS 11:1-2, 8-12

Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. Indeed, by faith our ancestors received approval.

By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to set out for a place that he was to receive as an inheritance; and he set out, not knowing where he was going. By faith he stayed for a time in the land he had been promised, as in a foreign land, living in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise.

For Abraham looked forward to the city that has foundations, whose architect and builder is God. By faith Sarah herself, though barren, received power to conceive, even when she was too old, because she considered him faithful who had promised.

Therefore from one person, and this one as good as dead, descendants were born, "as many as the stars of heaven and as the innumerable grains of sand by the seashore."
